



ArborVitae School of Traditional Herbalism is Hiring Clinic Mentors

ArborVitae offers a three-year clinically focused program of study for those seeking to gain and apply professional and clinical skills in traditional herbal medicine. A significant percentage of time spent in students' year three is participating in the supervised clinical herb clinic that is offered as a free service to the greater community, most often to underserved communities and people. As a part of the clinic, students conduct intakes, assess and write-up cases, and develop protocols for individual clients under the guidance of qualified herb practitioners.

And ArborVitae is now expanding! We are now seeking additional clinical mentors for our 2024-25 clinics and beyond.

This is a very special opportunity to be a part of our core herb clinic mentoring team, to support budding herbalists in needed and practical ways, to contribute to access to holistic herb health practice for those in need and to widen one's own clinical skills and wisdom.

We are looking for someone who:

- Has an herbal clinical practice from which to draw on.
- Uses and is proficient in energetic assessment.
- Applies at least one and is familiar with the energetic assessment methods of: Traditional Chinese Medicine, Ayurveda & Vitalist / Tissue State model.
- Applies and is familiar with tongue and pulse diagnosis.
- Use and familiarity of flower essence assessment and therapy is also helpful, but not necessary.
- Is available overall when the 14 clinics are held September – April. on 1 Tuesday and 1 Sunday a month. However, a mentor need not attend all clinics.
 - Please Note: Generally, Sunday clinics are held in-person in New Paltz, NY or at Mid-Hudson Valley locations & Tuesday clinics are held on Zoom (The in-person and virtual times is subject to change.) Overnight accommodations at the school are available to Clinic Mentors for in-person clinics.
 - Is able to give time 2 days after the clinic to review student case reviews and protocols in detail before they are sent out to clients.
- Has a desire to support the practice of Herbalism for underserved communities and people and the new practices of rising herbalists.

This position is open to seasoned and somewhat new practicing herbalists. Clinic mentor compensation is \$700 per clinic, which includes clinic observation, case review and reviewing final protocols (@ 4-7 cases). New mentors can take on less cases. Also, opportunities exist for mentoring the mentors for new clinic mentors. For questions, please email us. We may request more information upon meeting for an interview.
